

In my last report, I discussed what is NOT the secret to successful Forex trading.

## Now I'm going to tell you what it is.

### First let me put you in an imaginary situation...

This person – a stranger – sends you an email and tells you that he can change your life by giving you the source of unlimited wealth and the ability to make money whenever you wanted on the Forex market.

Your first reaction is “yeah right – whatever” and you reach to delete the email.

The problem is that **you don't know this guy** and you already think that he's lying, a scammer or plain nuts. After all, you get hundreds of emails every month from idiots trying to sell you something with promises of endless Forex wealth.

### Let's play this story out a little longer...

You decide against your better judgement **you reply to his email** something like: “Oh, ok, I don't believe a word of it, but tell me anyway”

And then you don't hear from him again. You've forgotten all about the mysterious stranger's email and you're busy looking for the secret elsewhere.

Two days later, your Outlook chimes **“You've got mail”**

It's him. His email reply is “If I tell you the secret, you have to promise me one thing. You have to do everything I tell you. **Leave nothing out.** If you can't do that, then I can't give you the secret.”

With nothing to lose, you reply “Of course. I'll do everything you tell me. I'll leave nothing out.”

And you hit the send button. You're thinking to yourself that you'll read through his “secrets”, pick out the good stuff (if anything) and ignore the rest. **After all – it's free and you have nothing to lose.**

Again you don't hear from the stranger. A day passes, then a week.

One morning while you're browsing online, the doorbell rings. You open the door, and there **on the step is a brown parcel**, with not a soul in sight. Puzzled, you walk inside, close the door and take a look at the parcel.

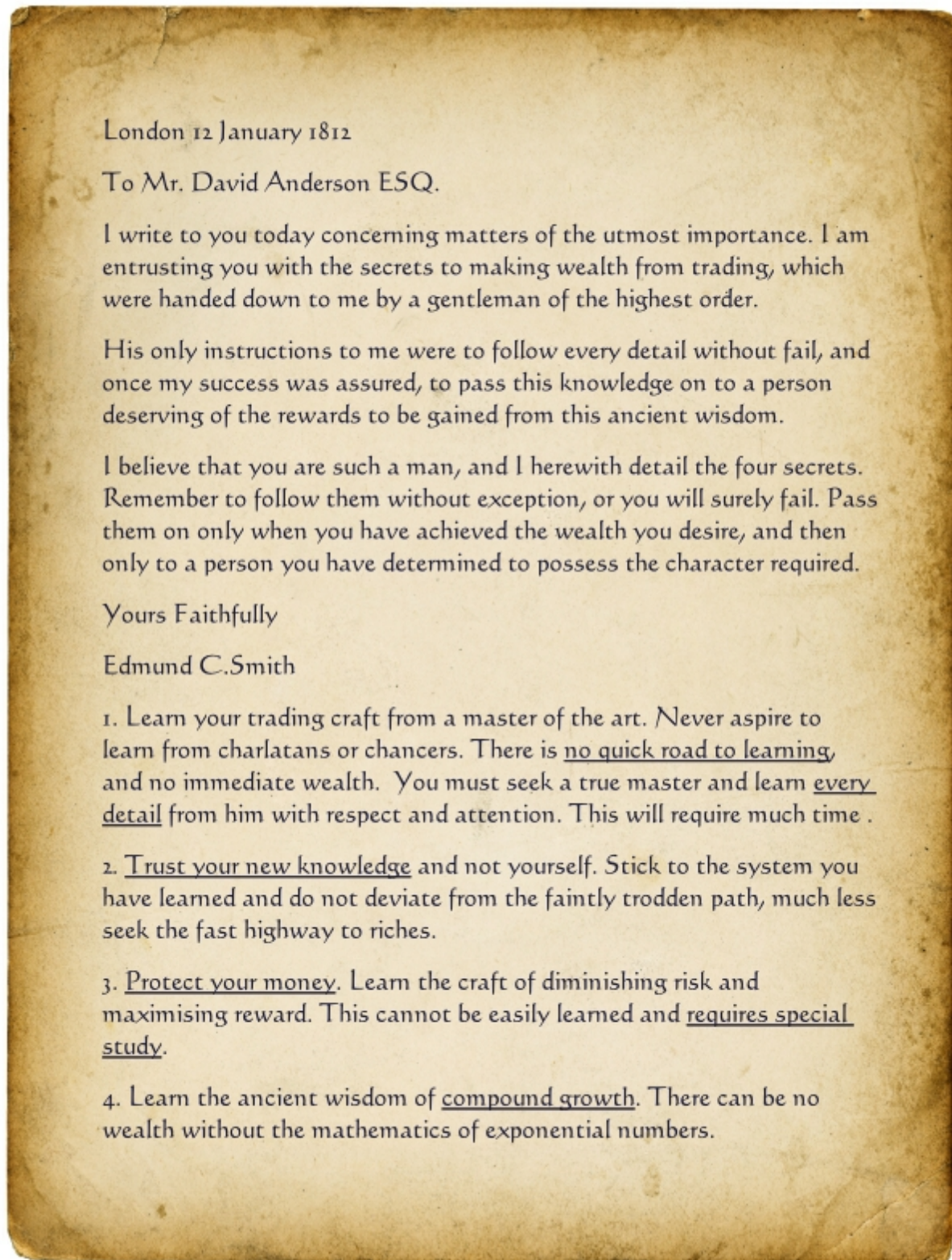
It's flat and light weight and there's a note stuck on top, hand-written with what appears to have been an old-fashioned ink pen (the kind you have to dip into a bottle)
